

CHANAVERM 7.5% / LEVAMISOLE 7.5% - FOR ANIMAL TREATMENT ONLY

- ❖ Chanaverm is a broad spectrum remedy for treatment and control of gastro-intestinal and pulmonary nematode infections in cattle and sheep.
- ❖ Chanaverm is highly effective against maturing and developing immature stages of levamisole susceptible major stomach and bowel worm species.
- ❖ For the control of roundworms and lungworms in cattle and sheep, safe for young pregnant and lactating animals.

DIRECTIONS:

- ❖ For oral administration only using standard dosing equipment at the rate of 7.5mg levamisole hydrochloride per 10kg bodymass.

DOSAGE:

CATTLE: 1ml chanaverm 7.5% per 10kg bodymass.

SHEEP: 0.5ml chanaverm 7.5% per 5kgs bodymass.

DOSE ACCURATELY ACCORDING TO BODYMASS.

PRECAUTIONS:

- ❖ Cattle must not be treated within 14 days before or after treatment with an organophosphorous compound.
- ❖ Overdose may cause cholinergic type symptoms such as salivation and muscle tremors.
- ❖ This is more likely in cattle and sheep.

WITHDRAWAL PERIODS:

- ❖ Cattle may only be slaughtered for human consumption 7 days after treatment.
- ❖ CHANAVERM must not be used in goats producing milk for human consumption
